

TASTING SHEET - SHIRAZ

Common descriptors for Shiraz include blackberry; mulberry; blackcurrants; plums; cherry; spice; pepper; licorice; earthy; tarry; leather; tobacco

Warmer regions are associated with primary fruit flavours such as blackberry; red berries; plums; cherries and spice; earthiness

Cooler regions tend towards white pepper; spice; blackcurrants and sometimes mintiness – the cooler the region the more peppery

Oak contact adds flavours such as vanilla; coconut; smokiness; charriness; cedar

Better known regions in Australia for Shiraz include the Barossa; McLaren Vale; Margaret River; Hunter Valley; Heathcote; Dookie!
