

TASTING SHEET - VIOGNIER

Common descriptors for viognier include apricot; stone fruit; honeysuckle; floral; ginger; spicy; exotic

Viognier has a unique texture which is often described as viscous; oily; mouthfilling

Viognier is frequently fermented or blended with shiraz to produce shiraz viognier and this combination adds vibrancy and fragrance to the shiraz, also giving it a silky texture in the mouth

Originally from the Rhone Valley in France, viognier has found a home in Australia where conditions produce excellent examples of this grape variety
